The committee met on 2/19. The Forestry data base project and the Ellington-Anaerobic Digester projects are nearing completion. Grant proposal have been submitted to RD for year 2 of the CT Farm Energy Program and The Air Quality Study at Brothers Quality. The committee is working on the budget for the development of a BMP guide for Agriculture with a focus on zoning. This proposal will be submitted to NRCS for funding under their Small Grants Program.
